Some of the best frontrunners were spotted in great form as the Sahara Force India development driver Alfonso Celis Jr. (Fortec Motorsports), the SMP Racing by AVF drivers, Matevos Isaakyan and Egor Orudzhev, and Roy Nissany (RP Motorsport). The team owned by Adrian Valles scored an important victory in 2016 in the Ardennes with the reigning driver Tom Dillmann.

Both Damiano Fioravanti and Konstantin Tereschenko opened the score in the Rookie championship. In this second meeting, the young Italian will be fielded in RP Motorsport.
